

TEACHERS RETURNING

2014 will see Linda Marsh and Janice Skiffington returning to Rotokauri School. It will be great to have their input into our school again and catch up with all their news from their experiences while on leave. Janice will be teaching in Room 4 and Linda will be teaching in Room 7.

In their absence we can consider ourselves very lucky to have secured the services of Lois Amery and Penni Houghton who have done an excellent job with our students. It is my opinion that New Zealand teachers rank up with best in the world and this is why they are so sought after overseas. Three years ago I spent some time over in the Middle East and was amazed by the number of New Zealand teachers working there and the regard people had for them.

CLASSES FOR 2014

We will initially start with 7 classes at the beginning of next year. As part of the planning process we determine the amount of children who are currently enrolled to come into our school in 2014 but we need to know the children who will be leaving at the end of 2013. With the exception of our current Year 8s, if your child will not be returning to Rotokauri School can you please inform the office as soon as possible so that classes can start to take shape.

MATHLETICS

Over the course of the year we have gone into detail about Mathletics and even had a parent evening about it. The school has kindly budgeted ten dollars a child to take part in this programme and has bought additional IT devices to help support its use in our school. We also trialled Mathletics earlier on this year and the feedback and excitement from the students was fantastic to say the least. Mathletics is currently used in approximately 30% of New Zealand Schools.

The positives that we have noted in relation to Mathletics are as follows:

- Supports the schools Maths focus for 2013 and 2014.
- The access for students and parents is 24/7.
- Breaks down a lot of negative attitudes that students may have towards Maths.
 One Hamilton School believes it has improved student engagement by 45%.
- This is a New Zealand based system and follows New Zealand curriculum content.
- It is multi-leveled.
- We found that when we trialled it with our students they started to set personal Maths goals.
- Our students found it fun and educational.
- It helps with collaborative learning.
- It gave our students a sense of achievement.
- Our students showed that they were more willing to take risks.
- The programme catered for different learning styles.

PARENT INPUT INTO MATHLETICS

Most schools ask for the full fee to be a part of this programme but as I said earlier we think this will have such an impact on maths learning that we as a school are prepared to budget a third of the cost.

A maths curriculum fee of \$20 will enable your child full access to this programme. That's less than 50 cents a week for what is one of the leading online learning platforms available anywhere.

We would ask that this be paid as soon as possible so that we can start Mathletics straight away in Term One of 2014.

Please pay Sharon at the office as soon as possible so that you child can be fully integrated into Mathletics.

VANDALISM

Our students are very proud of our school environment and therefore they would have been very disappointed to see large rubbish bins thrown up onto the sunshades. This could have caused thousands of dollars in damage were it not for Tracy Nicol who informed school staff. Thank you to the volunteers that tidied up the school after this incident.

Unfortunately we live in an age where certain individuals see this as an appropriate thing to do to someone else's property. To create such mayhem at our school required students of at least high school age. People who do these acts have no respect for other people and interestingly enough have little respect for themselves. Often these acts are committed by people who have low self-esteem and even lower morals.

BOT REPORT TO THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY

August and September

The Board of Trustees for Rotokauri School met on 31st August and 12th September. At the August meeting, we had the pleasure of hearing from the student council members who presented the results of a recent survey showing that Rotokauri School students would like more IT and sports equipment available to them. The safety of the students was also discussed. Our school is a very safe environment and students predominantly feel happy and supported in it. There is now an extra teacher on duty and more organised sports on at lunchtime for the students to enjoy. The School's website is currently under review – we look forward to seeing the finished result.

In the September meeting, special mention was made of the extremely high standard of speeches this year, with Rotokauri School winning the Year 5/6 and Open sections at the interschool speech competition at Te Uku. 


