

# AGRICULTURAL DAY 2021 - ROTOKAURI SCHOOL

The date for our Agricultural Day has been confirmed as Wednesday, 20<sup>th</sup> October 2021. There is no postponement date so the event will go ahead rain, hail or shine. Group Day will be held on Tuesday, 26<sup>th</sup> October at Gordonton School. The Waikato A & P Show Day is on Thursday, 28<sup>th</sup> October at Claudelands Show Grounds.

We would like to encourage as many children as possible to participate in our Agricultural Day, so please start to think seriously about having a lamb, goat or calf.

Please ring the school office between 8.30 am - 2.30 pm if you have trouble getting an animal as we have contact names of people who are happy to help out.

## Animals are judged in the following categories:

### Calves:

Rearing, Leading and Dairy Type

1. They must not be clipped or oiled
2. NAIT tags are compulsory.
3. Bull calves are accepted to Group Day level but not Show Day. They can go in the Beef category at Show Day.
4. Meal and water can be fed on the day.
5. T.B. Certificate to accompany calves on all competition days.

### Lambs:

Rearing, Leading and Most Obvious Pet

1. Lambs must not be washed
2. Milk can be fed only after the Most Obvious pet section.
3. Ram lambs may be entered for School Club Days, Group Days and Show Day.
4. **Please note there are new MPI animal health guidelines around the tailing/docking of lambs.**

### Goats:

Rearing, Leading and Most Obvious Pet

1. Milking, meat and feral goats may be washed but not fibre (Cashgora, Mohair) goats.
2. Buck kids are accepted to Group Day level but not Show Day.
3. Milk can be fed after the Most Obvious Pet section.

### **Competition Rules**

1. If a child is sick, a fellow pupil may show the animal at the judge's discretion in rearing type classes only.
2. No two pupils can show the same animal.
3. Parents may assist the children in cleaning animals on arrival and must leave the tie up area when requested.
4. No animals to be carrying lice.
5. Children's ages are as at show days.
6. Covered shoes (i.e. sneakers) must be worn by competitors while in the rings.
7. Only one animal per child (calf / lamb / goat sections).

### **Children's Age Groups:**

#### **Calves:**

Junior	5 to 7 year olds
Intermediate	8 to 10 year olds
Senior	11+ years

#### **Lambs and Goats**

Sub Junior	5 and 6 years
Junior	7 and 8 years
Intermediate	9 and 10 years
Senior	11 and over

### **Group Day**

This follows the same format as our school Agricultural day but on a larger scale as the students are competing against children from eight other schools in our area. **Pre-registration is required** and information booklets and name tags will be given out to those who wish to attend. These are available at the Rotokauri School office on Friday, 22<sup>nd</sup> October. Group day is being held on Tuesday, 26<sup>th</sup> October at Gordonton School. Any child who competes at our Agricultural Day and pre-registers is able to participate at Group Day.
