Values Family Homework




Round The Bridges

Ingredients:

- · 2 eggs, beaten
- · 1 tsp oil
- · 1 c cooked rice
- 1 c mixed frozen veges
- · 1/2 Tbsp soy sauce
- 1/2 Tbsp toasted sesame seeds (optional)
- 1 2 Tbsp spring onions, thinly sliced

Heat pan over medium heat, add oil. Pour in beaten eggs. As eggs cook, break them into smaller pieces using a fork. Add rice when the egg is partly (70 - 80%) cooked and stir. Add mixed veges and soy sauce and gently mix.

Add sesame seeds and spring onions, gently toss to coat. Serves 2.


