# SWIM SAFE – 67 DROWNINGS SO FAR THIS YEAR

On Tuesday the 3<sup>rd</sup> of December, the staff were involved in a professional development session facilitated by Wendy, from Kiwi Swim Safe – Safety in the Water. The Kiwi Swim Safe Programme includes eight modules:-

- Think Safety
- Go Under
- Glide
- Kick

- Stroke
- Survive
- Swim
- Apply Safety

It is extremely important for children to learn water safety and how to swim.

# **COOL SCHOOLS**

Next year we are introducing the Cool Schools Peer Mediation Programme to Rotokauri School.

Cool Schools is a whole-school proactive programme that teaches essential life skills for peaceful conflict resolution. The skills taught in this programme empower individuals to build positive, caring relationships with others, especially in times of conflict.

Staff are being trained in the holidays so that they can pass these skills on to your children.

The Cool Schools Learning areas are:

- Defining conflict
- Responses to conflict
- The role of the mediator
- The mediation process
- Problem solving and creating agreements that work
- Active listening
- Identifying and expressing feelings
- Using "I" statements
- Effective questioning
- Handling difficult situations

# SCHOOL LIBRARY

# CARPARK DANGER – LOADING ZONE

Probably the most dangerous area on our school grounds is the car park. Presently we have parents who park their car in the loading zone (by the bus shelter) and then walk off to collect their child. This clogs up the whole car park and endangers our students' safety. <u>Please do not leave your car unattended</u> and move forward along the line as the car in front moves on.

## SWIMMING POOL KEYS

Our school pool opened on 2<sup>nd</sup> December. Pool keys are available for sale at a cost of \$70. The swimming pool key also gives access to the tennis courts. Keys are only available for families that have students currently enrolled at Rotokauri School. Each year we sell a limited amount of keys to families who attend our school. There are only a few keys left.

# MATHLETICS


